This was an incredible year for the Bay League in Class B football. One week after North High won its eighth straight game with a convincing 25-10 win over West High, the little Saxons had only to defeat South High for a perfect season.

But South, which bounced back from losing its first game of the season to West, 20-7, rejuvenated itself to upset North last Friday afternoon, 13-12.

Coach Gary Ballengee

confessed he did not really believe his Spartans could win the game, but he said the kids do strange things.

The upset was real in the sense that South took a 7-0 halftime lead on a 40 yard touchdown run by Jim Mattathal who also carried for the extra point.

The margin was stretched to 13-0 in the third period on a 2-yard run by Rich Peterson. Steve Jarvis set up the score with a 30-yard run.

North got two touchdowns in the fourth quarter. One was a 50-yard pass thrown by Robbie Schmitz with a minute to go, but the tying point was muffed on a foul up in the backfield.

On the ensuing kickoff South was unable to run out the clock until after North

took three timeouts and forced South to punt out of danger.

Coach Ballengee, whose team had a 4-4-1 record a year ago, finished in the same company with North and West. Each was 8-1 for the year. Ballengee said Keith Brewer, Rick Feldman, Aric Parent, Gary Nordquist, Greg Johnson, Peterson, Jarvis and Mattathal had a great year and most of them are good futures for the varsity.

West High's Craig Kelly finished the year with four touchdowns against Santa Monica for a 35-0 victory. His season total is 18 TDs. Kelly, Gary Largent, an end, and Bob Hanson, a center and defensive tackle, have joined the varsity for the CIF playoffs.

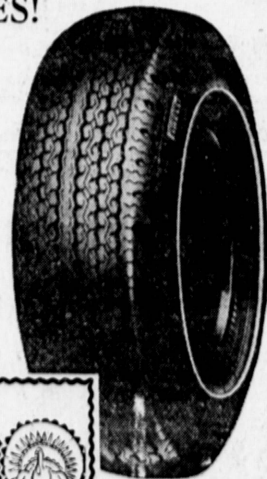
