NOTICE OF INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO GRANT EASEMENT TO THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on April 2, 1968, consummated an exchange of real property located within the Torrance Civic Center with the City of Torrance pursuant to Section 25365 of the Government Code and reserved for the County of Los Angeles a non-exclusive easement for ingress and egress over and across the property conveyed to said City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Torrance has requested a reciprocal non-exclusive easement for ingress and egress over and across the property conveyed to the County of Los Angeles, said easement inadvertently not having been provided in the exchange; and

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles and the City of Torrance will mutually benefit from this easement as a result of increased efficiency of vehicles providing emergency services to the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, NOTICE IS GIVEN that it is the intention of said Board of Supervisors, on the 23rd day of January, 1969, at 9:30 A.M. in the Hearing Room of the Board of Supervisors, 381 Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California 90012, to convey to the City of Torrance a non-exclusive easement for the ingress and egress of emergency vehicles over and across the County-owned real property described as follows:

That portion of Lot 5, Tract No. 2873, in the City of Torrance, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown on map filed in Book 109, pages 99 and 100, of Maps, in the office of the Recorder of said County, within the following described boundaries:

Commencing at the south-easterly corner of that certain parcel of land described in deed to County of Los Angeles, recorded as Document No. 4755, on May 28, 1957, in Book 54628, page 410, of Official Records, in the office of said Recorder; thence North 17°36'33" East along the easterly line of said certain parcel of land 284.00 feet to the true point of beginning; thence continuing North 17°36'33" East along said easterly line and its northerly prolongation 221.00 feet; thence North 72°23'25" West 158.00 feet; thence North 17°36'33" East to the northerly boundary of that certain parcel of land described as Parcel 1 in deed to County of Los Angeles, recorded as Document No. 2515, on December 21, 1961, in Book D1457, page 573, of said Official Records; thence westerly along said northerly boundary to a line parallel with and 250 feet westerly, measured at right angles, from said easterly line; thence South 17°36'33" West along said parallel line to a line which bears North 72°23'25" West and which passes through said true point of beginning; thence South 72°23'25" East to said true point of beginning.

Garden Checklist

1. As weather permits, plant annuals for spring bloom. Set out another planting of gladiolus for continual bloom.
2. Sweet peas may be planted now from seed for spring bloom. They are happiest with an early start so that they germinate while the weather is still cool.
3. Roses and many other deciduous trees and shrubs are in stock in wide selections at C.A.N. nurseries, now that the bare root season has arrived. New rose varieties should be ordered as soon as possible before supplies run short.
4. Deciduous fruit and nut trees may be pruned now. Roses should be pruned between now and mid-February.
5. Berries and grapes can be planted now, too. Berries want perfect drainage, but grapes will tolerate a soil that stays moist longer than will the berries.
