COUNTY supervisors have called for emergency state legislation to help pay the unexpectedly high cost anticipated for, of all things, a tax relief measure.

Experts indicate it will cost the county \$1.6 million to process the paper work necessary to mplement Proposition 1A, approved by the voters in No-rember. This chore, incidentally, involves 200 miles of paper

The state has authorized only about one-third of the \$1.6 miltion to the county, meaning that the balance would have to come out of the county fund — sup

ported by the property tax.
