

Harbor to Graduate Record Winter Class

Two hundred and ninety-seven students will make up the winter graduating class of Los Angeles Harbor College, it was announced today by Dr. Wendell C. Black, college president.

This is an increase of 60 over last year's class and makes it the largest winter class in the college's history.

Vehicle Stickers Available

All renewal notices for 1969 California motor vehicle and trailer registrations have been mailed out, Verne Orr, Department of Motor Vehicles director, said today.

Reminding Californians that the deadline for obtaining 1969 license plate stickers is Feb. 4, he said two groups of people

would be particularly well-advised not to wait longer before taking action:

"First, those who haven't received a renewal notice for a vehicle they own. They should take last year's card to the nearest DMV office and tell the clerk that they haven't received a card.

"SECOND, those who have brought a vehicle to California from out-of-state. Some of these people will have difficulty proving ownership, value, or date of purchase of the vehicle. They may even have to write to the place where they got the vehicle for documents they don't have."
