

Assignment TV

For many months it has been impossible to watch a television news show without hearing a campus militant in dark glasses unrel a list of "demands" to be met before his group will stop throwing rocks through schoolroom windows.

We have heard endless harangues by witless young men who advocate a democratic society without democracy, endorse violence to achieve peace, and spread hate in the name of love.

Anyone over 40 has heard the language before or read it in the Daily Worker and much of it sounds so old-fashioned it is almost nostalgic. In the name of free speech and the high moral hope most Americans have for open discussion, few viewers have complained.

AT TIMES like these I have found assurance in words by Thomas Jefferson, which lately I have been reciting like a rosary:

"I know of no safe repository of the ultimate powers of society but the people themselves, and if we think them not enlightened enough to exercise their control with a wholesome discretion, the remedy is not to take it from them but to inform their discretion by education."

But it is impossible to justify the staggering list of campus crimes, including intended murder and arson, committed in the name of educational freedom in the past 12 months. To hear them espoused nightly on television is becoming increasingly repugnant to moderates and liberals alike.

HAS THE role of television in the campus revolution been that of a tool, a reporter, an agitator or a perpetrator? If TV has been a tool in the campus revolts it has been a willing tool, because none but the most naive could fail to see that the militant favors the television soapbox more highly than any other platform. Yet empty time on newscasts must be filled—and with something new and

noisy every day—and the campus anarchists are willing to help fill it.

If TV has been an agitator or a perpetrator it should be a matter for the FCC. But there are no "ifs" when it comes to the shortcomings of TV's reporting talents. News departments are often more eager to score a scoop than to research facts. Just once I would like to hear a TV newsmen put a campus riot into its proper perspective by comparing the number of student rioters with the overwhelmingly greater number who are studying hard on the other side of the building.

I have a hunch that the concern of many viewers with the problem of "managed news" depends on whether it is managed FOR their interests or AGAINST them. But one thing seems clear: If TV newscasts have been an agitator in the campus revolution—and the system can't be changed without endangering freedom of speech—perhaps the "equal time" rule should be imposed, so we can hear the moderates now and then.
