

Burglary Charges Jail Four

Four area men were arrested on charges of burglary and receiving stolen property early Sunday after Torrance police chased their car from a local bar to Hermosa Beach.

A tip-off on a possible narcotics offense sent police tailing a car driven by Raoul C. Estrada, 28, of 512 N. Guadalupe St., Re-

When police finally stopped the car at the corner of 4th and Monterey Streets in Hermosa Beach, they reportedly found stolen credit cards, check books, airline tickets, and a wallet in the car and the pockets of Estrada's brother, Conrad J. Estrada's 6, 6, 2222 Arctica Place trada, 25, of 3727 Artesia Blvd. Estrada was also booked on forgery charges when he admit-ted using one of the cards to purchase gasoline.

Two passengers on the rear seat, from Torrance and Redondo Beach, were also arrested on burglary charges.
