(Continued from Page A-1) ity would be around 175,000 volumes.

The librarian also noted that studies of other city library systems revealed that the addition of such a facility could double or triple library use within the city.

**COUNCILMEN** agreed to let West determine where the cuts would be made, suggesting that custodial services might be subject to decreases.

West said he would try to save money deferring the hiring of some library staff members, including custodians, until the library is actually open. He had hoped to hire his staff members in advance so that they would be pre-trained for their positions.

West said he is reluctant to cut back on planned services, surmising that staffers would have to double up and work extra shifts.

**COUNCILMEN** will consider the library's regular operating budget today or tomorrow. Mrs. Louis Lanza, president of the Torrance League of Women Voters, told councilmen that the League formally supported the work of the library. She urged councilmen to restore the book acquisition fund, which is depleted because an increased amount of library bond money was used to finance the construction of the central library.

Mrs. Lanza also urged councilmen to take responsibility for completing the Southeast Torrance branch library because a commitment was made to build this library during the library bond campaign. Additional hearings are scheduled at 4 p.m. today, 8 a.m. tomorrow and at 4 p.m. Monday and Wednesday.

IN THE five years of the banquet, no person had won the top award for any two categories. This year the tradition was broken when Celia Wicislo was presented with the laurel for science. (She won the English award, too.)

Debbie Purmort won the social science award and Robert Saunders earned the laurels in speech. Bob has progressed to the nationals in Washington, D.C., in extemporaneous speaking and is rated as the sixth best speaker in the nation. Dana Powers received the award for work experience.

Two special awards were given: one to Alan S. Moore, for his devotion, time, and effort given to South High. He is retiring after 45 years of teaching various subjects, mainly math and science. The other special award was given to Mrs. John A. Lucas, for giving her husband, South's principal, so much time to devote to the school.

**ANOTHER** award presented was the Alan S. Moore trophy, given to the student who accumulates the greatest number of points in all of his algebra II classes. Karen Wicislo was the recipient.

The athletic-scholarship laurel is presented each year to the senior varsity athlete with the highest grade point average based on the three quarters of the current year. Jack Peterson was the award winner for 1969.

The only other award usually presented at the Spartan Laurels is the athlete of the year. Because two of the boys are still competing in CIF meets, the award will be presented June 10 at the Senior Awards Dinner.
