Some Observations
On Vietnam TripBy KENNETH HAN

I would like to give you some of my observations, that are strictly personal, of my visit to Saigon in Vietnam.

Let me emphasize, I was only there for three days and I am not a military or diplomatic expert — although I was in the Navy during World War II (the New Guinea Campaign) and have been in public office nearly a quarter of a century.

I talked with the soldiers. I observed the Third Evacuation Hospital and was tremendously impressed with the first aid medical treatment being administered to our American soldiers returning wounded from the battlefield. Every American can be proud of the excellent medical treatment given to our men.

I ALSO talked with "the little people" of South Vietnam, as well as with the Ambassador of the United States in Saigon, Ellsworth Bunker.

When I talked with Ambassador Bunker in his office, he told me there would be no military victory in Vietnam. There would only be a political settlement.

I visited with the South Vietnamese people. I went to their hospitals and to their Red Cross unit. The orphanage that took care of hundreds of children was an impressive sight I will never forget. The sorrow and grief at the South Vietnamese cemetery where the South Vietnamese war dead are buried will always be in my mind. The heroic American soldiers, especially the young boys, in the hospitals and in uniform but never complaining will be a sight I will never forget.

IN NO other war in the history of America has the serviceman received such excellent medical treatment, but there has been no other war over which the American people have been so divided.

If the peace negotiators in Paris would spend 30 minutes every day at a hospital to see the wounded and dying, they soon would not worry about whether the shape of a table is round or square and they would make every effort to make a sure, quick, just and lasting peace.

I feel that we in America must redefine our national goals.

It seems as though the greatest interest in Washington is to put a man on the moon in July. There seems to not be the energy necessary to bring peace in Vietnam.

AMERICA is divided on its college campuses. It is divided on racial tensions. It is divided on war and peace and yet, it appears to me, the number-one problem where every effort should be made is to end the war that has killed 33,329 men, has wounded 209,045 men and has cost \$100 billion.

May classes scheduled include general drafting, production drafting, applied descriptive geometry (all transferable to Cal State) and blueprint reading I and II.

General drafting teaches the underlying principles of drawing, geometric construction,

and sketching in preparation for advanced industrial and drafting courses.

high school drafting, studies the preparation of casting, forging, machine parts, and assembly drawings. Projection techniques for auxiliary views and dimensioning and tolerancing techniques as set forth in government specifications are emphasized.

Applied descriptive geometry offers a practical approach to the use of auxiliary projection in the solution of space relations of points, lines, and plane surfaces. The theory of revolution, intersections, developments, and pictorial views are covered. Working drawings of sheet metal are produced.

BLUEPRINT reading provides instruction in the reading and interpretation of materials which are detailed on blueprints. Symbols, conventions, dimensions, and language used in production and construction are included.

Summer session enrollment opens again during daytime hours from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Friday, June 23 through 27 and Monday, June 30. Evening registration runs from 6 to 8 p.m. Monday through 26, as well as Monday, through Thursday June 23 June 30.

Registration is open to high

school graduates and persons 18 years of age or older who are residents of the Los Angeles Junior College District. Registration is accomplished in one step with no permit request or entrance test required.
