Training Slated For West Coeds

Completion of one semester of classroom instruction on Nursing Skills has qualified 12 girls from West High to enter South Bay Hospital for the current semester to engage in clinical training.

Mrs. Dorothy Breckheimer, RN, teacher at West High provided classroom lectures last semester. The training period in the hospital is under the direction of Mrs. Dorothy Springer, RN, In-Service Training supervisor.

Purpose of the course is to "create an interest and some exposure in health service fields and the nursing profession," Mrs. Breckheimer said.

Mrs. Springer stated that the clinical training will include basic bedside care, limited to nurses aide duties, supervised at all times by the instructor.

"This is an example of the fine cooperation between two tax-supported institutions," Mrs. Springer continued. "The opportunity is offered to these young people on a community service basis."

The program is under the 1963 Vocational Education Act and is partially subsidized by the U.S. Government.
