

It adaptable to all high-performance engines: the big 1000-cubic-foot-of-air-per-minute size and a smaller 850-cfm size. The front two barrels are relatively small, for good street driving, which is about 80 per cent of the driving time for most motorists, and the back two barrels are oversized to get maximum air flow for track competition.

THINGS TO COME — If the new spirits category — light whisky — created last year by the federal government catches on with the public, it will give a needed boost to domestic whisky output. Distillers can start selling the new category after July 1, 1972. Light whisky is taken off the still at between 160 and 180 proof and is stored in used barrels, producing a drink relatively low in flavoring agents.
