Candle on Armchair Sends Youth to Jail

A landlord-tenant dispute became a burning issue Monday afternoon when the tenant allegedly set fire to a chair in a rented apartment.

Booked for felony burning of personal property and possession of flammable materials was Paul W. Yarnnton, 22, of 4312 W. 180th St., Apt. 7. Police made the arrest about 3 p.m.

The suspect had glued a candle to the arm of an upholstered chair with flammable glue, police said.

Yarnnton's roommate told police the suspect let the candle burn down and ignite the chair. The roommate said he twice tried to extinguish the flame and Yarnnton twice relit it.

At that point the landlady came to the door to serve the two with an eviction notice. When she asked Yarnnton what

he was doing, he replied, "Oh, just burning the chair."

The landlady put out the blaze with a fire extinguisher, police said.

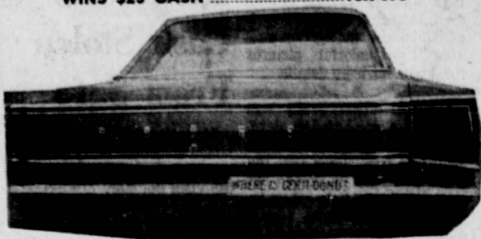
