## 'Sky Above, Mud Below' Scheduled

A documentary film that has become almost a classic adventure will be presented by the Los Angeles County Museum of Natural History at Los Angeles Harbor College.

"The Sky Above-The Mud Below" will be shown at 8 p.m., Thursday, April 24, at the Seahawk Center. Admission is free.

In 1959 a French-Dutch expedition began a 1,000-mile trek through primitive, uncharted areas of New Guinea. Seven months later, only two members of the party had completed the trip. They survived the natural hazards of the land and encountered pygmies, headhunters and cannibals, some of whom were living as they did 7,000 years ago.

"The Sky Above-The Mud Below" is presented as a cultural service to the community by the Museum of Natural History.
