Plan a Treat for Her

Well, you've got all sorts of spots around the Southland to take Mother on Her Day which, incidentally, will come up here next Sunday, May 11.

All right, so as not to show any partiality, let's take these releases as they come from this stack of papers here. And the first one we come across is a small item from Pete and Anne Petroff at their BBQ Pete Restaurant in Inglewood.

Pete says, "Mother can't cook? No, especially on Mother's Day so bring her on down for the world's best BBQ chicken and ribs." And that's the Petroff sentiments and not a bad thought, at that.

Then Bill Fremont comes up with the idea that if you can't afford to fly Mother to Spain on Her Day, it might be a good plan to take her to the Matador Restaurant on West Pico for an authentic Spanish dinner.

Most restaurants present a limited menu on this gala holiday but The Matador will be offering its regular bill of fare and at no increase in price. This starts at \$2.95 for the

steak and Spanish dinners.

There will be one exception at The Matador on Mothers Day, however. They'll open earlier — like 3 in the afternoon and will present some early Flamenco entertainment. Not only in the Flamenco Room but in the main dining room as well.

There'll be a special menu offered at the Pen and Quill Restaurant in Manhattan Beach that day that will have seven different items on the complete dinner beginning at \$3.25.

These special items will be served starting at 12 noon and will continue up through 9 in the evening. The number here is 772-2257.

Mother's Day activities will begin at 11:30 in Redondo Beach at Millie Riera's Seafood Grotto, 1700 Esplanade. That's at Avenue I.

But of course you might think in terms of Mother's Day every day at The Grotto with such entrees as sword fish, abalone from Morro Bay, and white sea bass, not to mention the always popular bouillabaisse plus steaks and a wide pasta selection.

The prices are reasonable and include a choice of salad, turtle soup or clam chowder, garlic bread and Sicilian pizza. A fine spot to take Mother next Sunday overlooking the Pacific. The number here is 378-1483.
