Aeronca will supply all the wing flaps and wing vanes (16 per ship set) under a contract from AVCO's Aerostructures Division in Nashville, Tenn.
AVCO has a contract from
Lockheed for the L-1011 wing structures.

The flaps and vanes are parts of the trailing edge of the wings and are extended during takeoff and landing to provide high lift performance. high lift performance.

FABRICATION of the as-FABRICATION of the as-semblies involves aluminum, titanium, and bonded com-ponents. Production will be centered in Aeronca's Middle-to w n Division, Middletown, Ohio, with support to be pro-vided by the Aerocal Division in Torranse. in Torrance.

First deliveries of the L-1011 wing to Lockheed are scheduled for March of 1970 and Aeronca's first delivery of flaps and vanes to AVCO will be in January, 1970. The initial contract release to Aeronca covers 100 ships sets and has a value of \$7.7 million.

Deliveries under the total contract value will run through 1974. The contract, as nego-tiated with AVCO, is for a total of 350 ship sets plus one static test unit

way Patrol commissioner.

Studies of holiday accidents in 1968 reveal that two-thirds of in 1968 reveal that two-thirds of the fatal crashes took place within 25 miles of the drivers' homes, Sullivan said. He stated, also, that the majority of the fatal holiday accidents happened in daylight, and that less than a quarter of these daylight accidents involved a drinking driver.

"YOU DON'T have to be drunk, on unfamiliar roads, overtired or driving after dark to get involved in a serious ac-cident, although these things do contribute to many the commissione

"Most fatal accidents on long holiday weekends involve some social or recreational jaunt close to home. And, sig-nificantly, in most such fatal accidents in 1968, a seat belt was not in use.

"Perhaps people on a short trip, close to home, feel safe without a seat belt. Tragic experience shows they are wrong," he said.
